Unique Whites

- 2008 **Sitos de Bodegas “Con Class”** Verdejo, Viura & Sauvignon Blanc (Rueda, Spain) 32.
Light straw color with aromas and flavors of grapefruit, gooseberries, grassy notes, and hints of pineapple. This light bodied, tart, juicy white has a clean refreshing finish, and pairs well with salads, seafood, and light fare.
- 2007 **Gentilini “Aspro Classic”** Robola, Tsaoussi & Sauvignon Blanc (Cephalonia, Greece) 35.
Medium-bodied with lovely aromas of citrus, honey, and tropical fruits. There’s a wonderful melony fleshiness, with nice minerality and a mouthwatering long finish.
- 2008 **Boutari** Moschofilero (Mantina, Greece) 35.
This light, crisp refreshing white from the Peloponnese is enticing in the nose and on the palate. Clean citrus, floral and melon aromas and flavors make this a great aperitif or complement to many types of cuisine.
- 2007 **Lícia** Albariño (Rias Baixas, Spain) 40.
Light straw colored and light to medium bodied with lovely aromas of green apples, citrus kiwi and honeycomb. There’s excellent concentration of flavors on the palate and a healthy dose of acidity that comes ripping through and carries the flavors across the long juicy finish.
- 2008 **Domaine Pélaquié “Laudun”** (Côtes-du-Rhône Villages) 40.
Clairette, Bourboulenc, Grenache Blanc, Viognier & Roussanne
Pale gold with hints of green, the nose is elegant and subtle, with hints of white peaches, pears, lemon peel and orange blossom. The texture is silky, and the bright flavors float across the palate with freshness and a long stony finish.
- 2008 **Château Martet** (Sainte-Foy, Bordeaux) 40.
Semillon, Sauvignon Gris, Sauvignon Blanc & Muscadelle
Medium-bodied and lively with tangy lime, orange and grapefruit notes in the nose and on the palate. There are hints of white flowers, pleasant minerality, and a creamy oiliness that carries the flavors through a long refreshing finish.
- 2008 **Lícia** Albariño (Rias Baixas, Spain) 40.
Light straw colored and light-medium bodied with aromas of citrus, green apple, kiwi and honeycomb. There’s excellent concentration of flavors on the palate and a healthy dose of acidity that comes ripping through carrying the flavors through the long juicy finish.

Unique Whites

- 2008 **Saxon Brown “Cricket Creek Vineyards”** Semillon (Alexander Valley) 45.
Flashy with ripe pineapple, guava, melon and stone fruit aromas and flavors. There’s some minerality, but the wine is more fleshy and ripe with a rich texture and a long, juicy finish.
- 2007 **Cold Heaven** Viognier (Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara) 50.
Vibrant lemon and lime aromas are deepened by notes of tangerine and pear. Crisp, stony citrus and orchard fruit flavors, with a note of honeysuckle are strikingly fresh and pure. With lively acidity, this wine carries its aromas and flavors of tropical fruits and exotic white flowers with grace and elegance.
- 2007 **Caymus “Conundrum”** (California) 55.
Sauvignon Blanc, Muscat Canelli, Chardonnay & Viognier
Powerful aromas of green apple, tangerine zest & honeysuckle. Core flavors of apricot, melon, pear and light vanilla backed by the sparkling acidity of citrus fruits. The lush, creamy, mouth-filling texture with floral and bright tropical fruit notes leads to a full, rich finish.
- 2006 **François Chidaine “Clos Habert** Chenin Blanc (Loire) 60.
Richly complex nose of apricot and quince preserves, toasted almonds, green tea and honey. Rich and creamy in texture yet elegant and wafting on the palate with mouthwatering minerality and an exceptionally long finish.
- 1999 **Lopez de Heredia “Viña Gravonia”** Viura (Rioja, Spain) 60.
Deep yellow-gold in color, with an exotically perfumed bouquet of candied tangerine, vanilla, dried flowers, and lots of hazelnuts. On the palate the wine is medium-bodied with citrus, nectarine and apricot flavors that build with nuttiness and spiciness. Finishes on a gentle note with a strong echo of vanilla bean. Complex and delicious.
- 2007 **Alzinger “Loibner Steinertal” Smaragd** Grüner Veltliner (Wachau, Austria) 100.
Pale yellow-green in color. The nose is an exotic mix of juicy tropical mangoes, lemony citrus, fresh green beans, snap peas, melon, peach cobbler, and white pepper. The palate is equally impressive, dazzling with power and elegance. The lush aromas are joined with flavors of green apple, apricots, and fresh pears. There’s amazing, mouth-watering minerality that keeps the balance and the finish is long and satisfying.

WHITE

Saxon Brown "Cricket Creek Vineyards" Semillon (Alexander Valley) 2008

100% Semillon from a small block of 25-year-old vines. This complex, flavorful white starts out with orange and lemony citrus, pineapple and baking spices on the nose. There's some

fleshy melon, peach and mineral notes emerging as the wine opens. On the palate the wine is layered with spicy peach, tropical pineapple, guava, and sweet lemon confit over a round frame. There's some minerality there, like a fine spine holding the components together. The body is medium-full and as the ripe fruit, spice and tart elements mingle across the palate new flavors continue to emerge. The finish is long and satisfying. \$45.

RED

Castello Monaci "Pilùna" Primitivo (Salento, Puglia) 2007

This southern Italian gem bursts from the glass with fresh, flowery aromas and nuances of black plums with strong notes of vanilla and cherry. On the palate, the wine greets you with generous ripe red and black fruit, hints of licorice and sweet herbs. It is medium-bodied with silky texture, good structure, and a long, juicy finish. Pairs well with roasted meats, hearty pasta dishes, and cheese. #803 \$40.

Perticaia Sagrantino (Montefalco, Umbria) 2001

Sagrantino, Umbria's signature grape is known for powerful, long lived wines of immense depth and complexity. This traditional, small production gem (500 cases) from Perticaia starts out big and brooding on the nose, with black fruit, earth, plums, cinnamon and spice. On the palate it begins big and dry with leather, herbs and spice, but quickly opens to reveal more raspberry, soft plum, red and black cherry, beets and mushrooms. Full bodied with layers of earth, spice and fruit, this wine begs for grilled or braised red meats, game, or hearty tomato based pasta dishes. The finish is long, dry and very smooth. #796 \$100.

Rocche dei Manzoni “Quatr Nas” 1998 (Langhe, Piedmont)

This “Super Piedmont” from the esteemed Barolo maker Roche dei Manzoni is a blend of 50% Nebbiolo with Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir and Merlot. The austere, noble Nebbiolo serves as a foundation, while the four international grapes smooth out Nebbiolo’s serious demeanor. A full, complex wine, Quatr Nas holds on to Nebbiolo’s rose petal, earth and tobacco notes, but also shows blueberries, blackberries, plums, tar and herbs. Beautifully balanced with mature, integrated tannins, this elegant wine pairs wonderfully with white meats, game and hearty pasta dishes. #733 \$100.

Savanna “Sogno Due” Falanghina 2005 (Campania)

Falanghina is one of Italy’s ancient indigenous grape varieties, and one of its most storied, as it is believed to have been used to make Falernian, the most famous wine in ancient Rome. Today it is used to produce tasty aromatic whites like this one. Pale gold in the glass, with a bright nose of Asian pears and wet stones. On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied with ripe green apples, pears, a touch of vanilla, and a pleasant minerality that balances the finish. \$30.
